

ELEMENTARY SUMMER CAMPS

For the summer of 2010, the Cocalico School District will be offering four "Summer Camp" enrichment classes for elementary children residing within Cocalico School District.

The first offering is **Environmental Escapades** taught by Elisabeth Sherman. During this four-day course, some of the following topics will be explored: predator/prey; bird hike; stream study; pollution; and a garbage scavenger hunt. Other topics will be added to make this a truly memorable experience for children.

The second offering is **Sign Language Camp**. In this camp, Amy Hess will provide students with basic conversation skills and vocabulary in American Sign Language. Aspects of the deaf culture will also be explored in addition to signing patriotic songs.

The third offering is **Hiking For Fitness!** In this offering, Peter Rohrer will introduce students to hiking as a way to develop and maintain fitness. The camp will take place at Middle Creek and children will learn the importance of cardiovascular, muscular, and mental fitness in maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

The final summer camp offering is **iLife Camp for Kids!** In this camp, Kelly Martin will be working with students in the use of iMovie, iPhoto, and Garage Band to create a DVD. Children will compose their own music and create an iMovie with photos. Children will receive a copy of their work on DVD to share with others.
