The reconvened meeting of the Cocalico School Board's November 18, 2019 public meeting opened on Monday, December 2, 2019 at 7:30 P.M. with Secretary Sherri Stull conducting a roll call of Board members present.

As this was the meeting for re-organization, "hold-over" Board member Mr. Graybill motioned that Mr. Brenner, "hold-over" Officer of the Board, act as Temporary President to begin the re-organization process. Mr. Sensenig, "hold-over" Board member, seconded the motion and asked for all in favor of the Motion. All hold-over members voted yes, except for Mr. Brenner who abstained.

Temporary President Brenner publicly accepted the certification of elections, naming all those re-elected and newly elected. He then invited District Justice Nancy Hamill to swear in the re-elected and newly elected board members. It was noted by Judge Hamill that all those being sworn in will be serving four-year terms except for Mr. Buckwalter, who was elected to a two-year term.

Following the swearing in, Temporary President Brenner opened the floor for nominations for the office of President. Mr. Graybill nominated Rev. Eshleman for the office of President for a one-year term. As there were no other nominations, Mr. Graybill made a motion to close the nominations, seconded by Mr. Sensenig, and unanimously agreed to by the Board. Temporary President Brenner then asked for a motion and second to have the Secretary cast a unanimous ballot for Rev. Eshleman to serve as School Board President for a one-year term of

office. Mr. Graybill made the motion which was seconded by Mr. Sensenig. Roll call vote, all members voting yes, except Rev. Eshleman, who abstained. Motion carried 7-0.

Mr. Brenner then turned over the meeting to Rev. Eshleman, newly elected School Board President, to complete the re-organization. President Eshleman opened the floor for nominations for the office of Vice President. Mr. Brenner nominated Mr. Graybill. As there were no other nominations, Mr. Sensenig made a motion to close the nominations, seconded by Mrs. Fox, and unanimously agreed to by the Board. President Eshleman then asked for a motion and second to have the Secretary cast a unanimous ballot naming Mr. Graybill as School Board Vice President for a one-year term of office. Mr. Buckwalter made the motion which was seconded by Mrs. Fox. Roll call vote, all members voting yes, except Mr. Graybill, who abstained. Motion carried 7-0.

On a motion made by Mr. Sensenig and seconded by Mr. Buckwalter, the Board accepted the following appointments as presented by Rev. Eshleman:
