

Homeschool Education Fact Sheet

Start of School Year:

To be submitted no later than August 1

- Signed, Notarized Affidavit
- Educational Objectives (for each subject for each student)
- Immunizations (current and up-to-date) or Religious Exemption Documentation.
- Health/Medical Examination or Religious Exemption Documentation
 - Upon registering a new home school student, and
 - Students in grades 6 & 11
- Dental Exam or Religious Exemption Documentation
 - Upon registering a new home school student, and
 - Students in grades 3 & 7
- High School Diploma or GED of Supervisor (if not previously provided)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Please note: The compulsory age for homeschool education is NOW 6-18 years. Thus, a child turning 6 by September 1 of that school year must be enrolled in a public, private, charter, or homeschool program.

End of School Year:

To be submitted *no later than* June 30

- End-of-year Evaluation, including Affirmation of Statewide Tests Completed by Students in Grades 3, 5, & 8.
- Evidence of Evaluator's Certification (if not previously provided) (Per 24P.S. 13-1327.1(e) this person must be one of the following:
 - o Licensed Clinical Psychologist
 - School Psychologist
 - o PA Certified Teacher with two years grading experience at the level they evaluate
 - Non-public School Teacher or Administrator with two years PA teaching experience with the last 10 years at the level they evaluate
 - \circ $\,$ Person with other qualifications and the proper consent of the Superintendent

Important Notes:

- Parents of students entering 9th grade who are considering attending the CTC during their senior year should consult the Educational Planning Guide posted on the district's website. It is advisable to check in with the high school guidance office prior to your student's 11th grade year to ensure your student is on track to complete all requirements necessary for CTC enrollment.
