Eligibility Requirements

Head Start Eligibility - Foster children, children experiencing homelessness, families that receive SSI or TANF & families that have an annual gross income at or below 100% of the guidelines are eligible.

If annual income is between 101% – 150% we can still process an application however odds of being selected for a Head Start slot are slim.

If your income is above 150% we are unable to process a Head Start application

PreK Counts Eligibility - Families that have an annual gross income at or below 300% of the guidelines are eligible.

If applying for Head Start or PreK Counts you will be asked to provide your child's birth certificate, immunizations, and your families' proof of income for 12 months.
