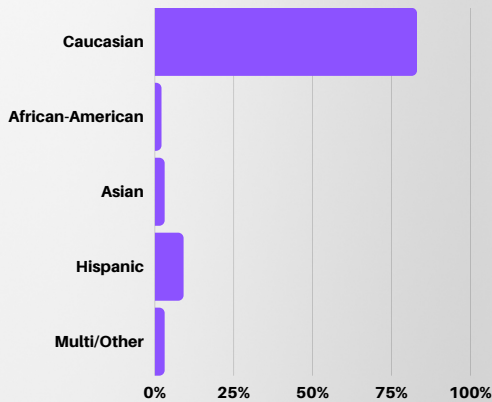

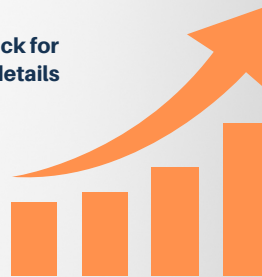

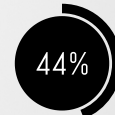

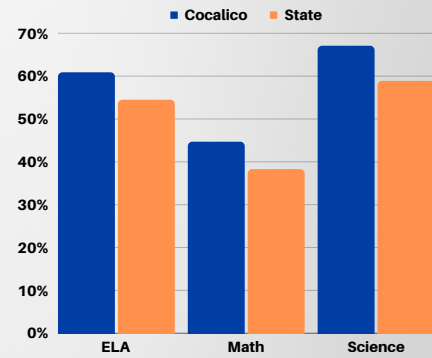

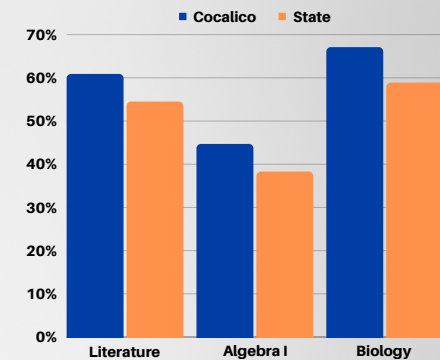
### Elementary - PSSA Exams



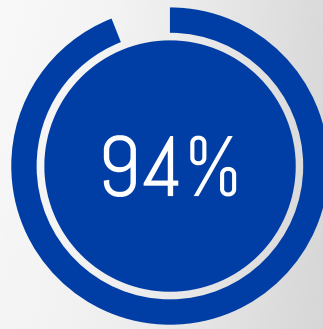
### Middle School - PSSA Exams



### High School - Keystone Exams

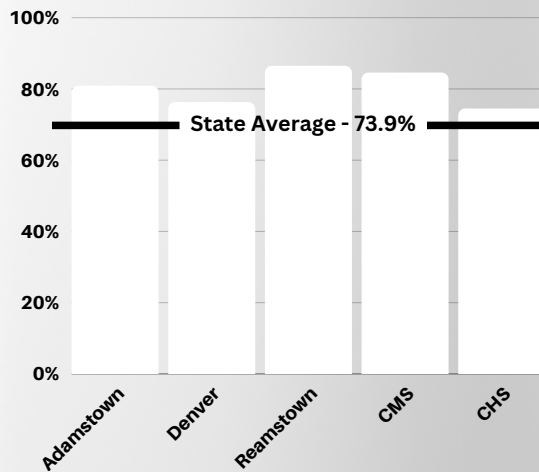


## 4-Year Cohort Graduation Rate\*



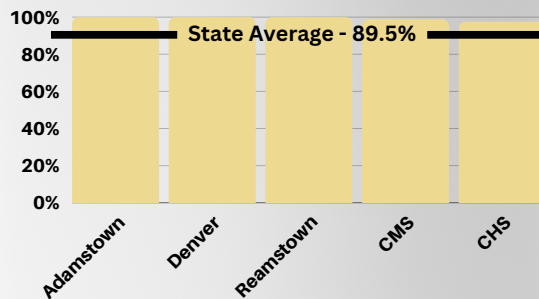
